

## Father Joe's Villages

### Organization Description

Father Joe's Villages is recognized nationwide as a leader in providing services to the homeless. Their Continuum of Care model combines a multitude of programs in one location for "one-stop shopping."

### Project Description

Father Joe's Villages will provide technical assistance in the form of workshops and year-round mentoring for 50 FBO/CBOs. They will issue sub-awards to up to 30 organizations over the 3 years of the project. The project is called the Village Training and Intermediary Institute.

### Geographic Scope of Project

The project will serve nonprofit organizations nationwide, with primary focus on the state of California.

### Partnering Organizations

The staff of Father Joe's Villages will be providing the training and mentoring/coaching, but they have grown over the years into a consortium of 21 social service agencies and have established 8 residences.

### Sub-Awards

Using an RFP process, Father Joe's Villages plans to issue sub-awards averaging \$27,000 to approximately 30 agencies over three years (6 in year one, and 12 each years two and three).

### Project Objectives

Targeting a diverse range of FBOs and CBOs, especially small organizations, this project seeks:

1. To improve the efficiency and effectiveness in program management and operation.
2. To improve access to varied sources of government and private funding.
3. To expand type and reach of services based on successful program models.

### Project Strategies

- Provide ongoing full-day workshops to improve knowledge and skills of selected organizations, approximately 7 sessions per quarter.
- Provide ongoing mentoring/coaching of key staff in selected organizations drawing on expertise of approximately 30 in-house staff.
- Issue sub-awards to build capacity of selected organizations.
